

## **Ranch update, Sept 14<sup>th</sup>**

*Since the last ranch update, we have had some incredible additions. Firstly, the community horses “Daisy and Cheyenne” are doing great, they miss all the attention they were once getting but they are enjoying life.*

*The cows are now officially here! Tl’azt’en Nation is now in the cattle business with 8 mother cows and 8 calves at side. The cows are 7 blacks with one black baldy (a black cow with a white face), all calves are black and there are 7 heifers (female) and 1 steer (a castrated bull calf). The herd is out in the pasture area, with access to the big pens for water and salt. Please do remember that the pasture fenced area is electric.*

*The latest equine addition is “Dolly”, she is a 10 yrs. old half draft (heavy horse) mare. She is a big horse but very gentle. She will be used as a teaching horse as well as a ranch horse.*

*The chickens are busy pumping out eggs! A typical day will see us gathering 15-20 eggs. We will look at expanding the flock in time to ensure we can keep up with the demand.*

*The ranch will now begin to prepare for the fall and winter working projects.*
