Owners are now required to contain their animals within their home, or within the perimeter of their residence. If your animal is outside, it must have a collar and be on a chain or other mechanism to prevent them from running freely, beyond 15 metres of your home, or outside of your presumed yard.

In response to the growing animal population and reports of animal aggression, the Tl'azt'en Nation Chief and Council will be taking action to prevent further harm and for the utmost protection of physical safety for Tl'azt'en Nation residents.

As per <u>BCR No. 1965</u> all residents of Tl'azt'en Nation who own or care for an animal, must complete an ANIMAL REGISTRATION FORM, and agree to the TL'AZT'EN NATION RESPONSIBLE ANIMAL OWNER AGREEMENT.

Failure to do so may result in your animal being removed or apprehended by an animal care agency upon direction from Tl'azt'en Nation for the safety of the community.

As a responsible owner, it is at your own cost to provide a collar and chain/line for your animal.

Any aggressive or problematic animals may be removed at short notice.

If you cannot provide care for your animal due to financial/mobility constraints and would like to surrender your animal, contact the administration building and we can contact a delegated animal care agency.
